

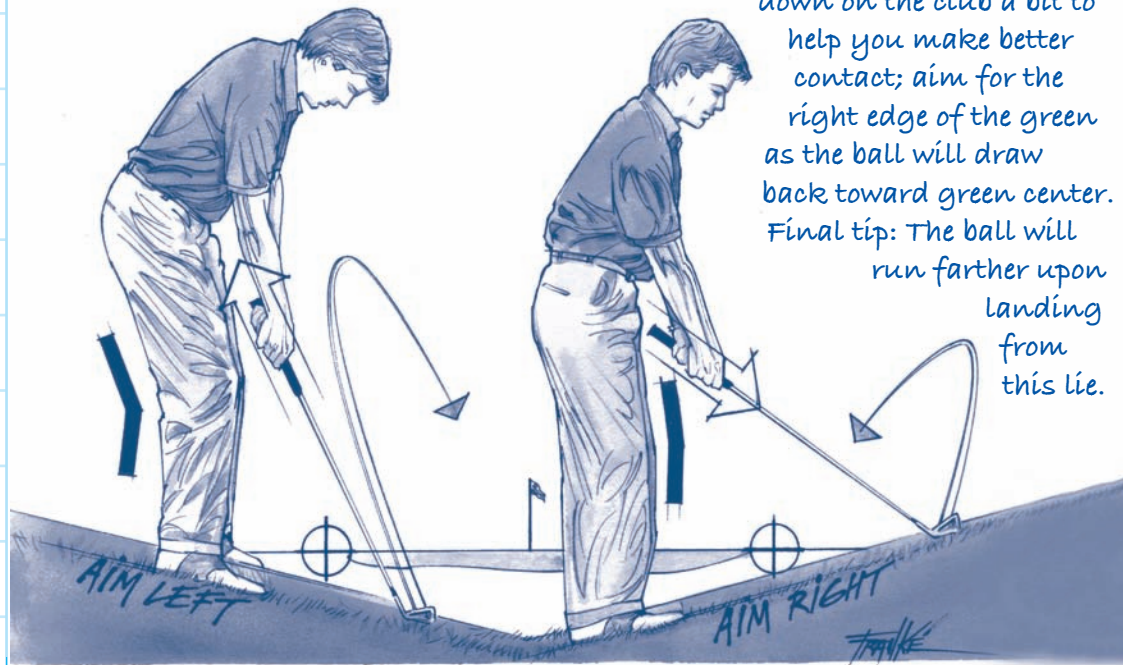

## Shot Curves From Sidehill Lies

When playing a hilly course, remember that sidehill fairway lies will cause the ball to curve. Assuming you normally hit the ball straight, when the ball is below your feet, the shot will fade or slice right. Bend your knees slightly more than usual to get the club down to the ball; and aim for the left edge of the green, allowing the shot to fade back toward the middle.

When the ball is above your feet, it will tend to hook left. Choke down on the club a bit to help you make better contact; aim for the right edge of the green as the ball will draw back toward green center. Final tip: The ball will run farther upon landing from this lie.
